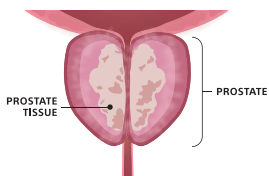

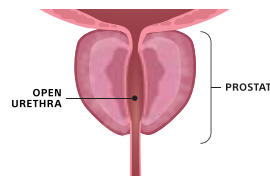
Rezūm Water Vapor Therapy is a short, in-office procedure that uses the natural energy stored in water vapor, or steam, to shrink enlarged prostates.^{1,2}

Rezūm Therapy is typically performed right in your urologist's office, or at an outpatient surgery facility. During each 9-second treatment, sterile water vapor is released throughout the targeted prostate tissue. The number of treatments varies depending on the size of your prostate. Over time, your body's natural healing response absorbs the treated tissue, shrinking the prostate. With the extra tissue removed, the urethra opens, reducing BPH symptoms. Most patients begin to experience symptom relief in as soon as two weeks, and maximum benefit may occur within three months.*^{1,2}



Before

An enlarged prostate can squeeze the urethra, making it difficult to pass urine from the bladder.



After

Following treatment with Rezūm Therapy, your body heals and the extra tissue is gone, the urethra opens and urine can flow freely.

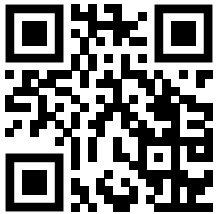
